The Beam of Light was inspired by an unforgettable image I saw while studying at the University of Michigan. It was a very dark and early morning in a restaurant during a freezing cold winter. A beam of light, with warmth and power, came through a tiny hole between two pedestrian lights, traveling across a 4-lane street, breaking through the glass window of the restaurant, and finally on to the plate in front of me. The beam of light was very thin, but its hidden power was strong enough to break through the mystery and coldness of the dark. This work uses flowing melodic lines and contrasting musical elements to express the depth and dramatic power that was hidden within the light. The piece was commissioned by clarinetist, Dr. Jun Qian.
